



Please note the following guidelines for visiting Reciprocal Clubs:

1. Reciprocal club facilities, especially in India, are for ROSL NZ members who are travelling **outside** the country in which they reside or work. NZ Reciprocal Clubs are available to ROSL NZ members outside their own city of residence.
2. To obtain a letter of introduction, contact the ROSL NZ Director giving a minimum of ten days notice. Please supply your membership number, club(s) to be visited and the **dates of the visits**. (*No open ended time periods*)
3. For reservations and further information, please contact the clubs directly. Right of entrance is at the discretion of the Reciprocal Club's management.
4. Letters of introduction can be issued for a maximum of 30 days a year per city. They should not span more than two calendar months.
5. Letters of introduction **cannot** be faxed or emailed to members.
6. Accounts incurred at Reciprocal Clubs **must** be settled on departure.
7. Methods of payment and whether guests are permitted or not, vary from club to club. Please contact Reciprocal Clubs directly for details of their individual policies.
8. In the residential clubs, certain facilities may be limited to those staying. Please check with the Reciprocal Club first.
